

Board of Aldermen Special Call Meeting December 9, 2024 Minutes

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Ocean Springs met in a Special Call Meeting at the Civic Center at 6:00 p.m. on December 9, 2024. Mayor Holloway presided, and Aldermen Burgess, Authement, Wade, Cox, Papania, and Impey were present. Alderman Blackman was absent. Also present were City Attorney Will Norman, Deputy City Clerk Vicky Hupe, Patrol Officer Marshall Riff, Public Works Director Allan Ladnier, Parks & Recreation Director Stephen Glorioso, Community Development Director Carter Thompson, City Planner Elizabeth Dill, and Planning Administrator Hannah Sullivan.

The meeting was properly noticed in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. §21-3-21.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Alderman Cox, seconded by Alderman Papania, and unanimously carried to accept the agenda.

1. Community Meeting regarding the zoning in the newly annexed areas

The Community Development Director delivered a PowerPoint presentation focusing on the zoning of the annexed area and addressed audience questions. The presentation provided detailed zoning information, which was also included in informational packets distributed to attendees. These packets featured maps, current county zoning details for the annexed area, and the most relevant city zoning classifications. Attendees were given note cards to submit written comments and recommendations to the Planning Department regarding the proposed transition of zoning from county to city classifications.

A motion was made by Alderman Impey, seconded by Alderman Cox, and unanimously approved to adjourn. The meeting formally ended at 6:30 p.m., though the audience remained until 7:00 p.m. to view maps and ask additional questions.
